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



UNIFORM COMPUTER INFORMATION TRANSACTIONS ACT

PURPOSE:

The Uniform Computer Information Transactions Act represents the first comprehensive uniform computer information licensing law. This act uses the accepted and familiar principles of contract law, setting the rules for creating electronic contracts and the use of electronic signatures for contract adoption-thereby making computer information transactions as well-grounded in the law as traditional transactions.

ORIGIN:

Completed by the Uniform Law Commissioners in 1999, and amended in 2000 and 2002.

Digital Signature Act of 1999

- HR 1572 IH.
Date introduced: April 27, 1999.
Sponsor: Rep. Bart Gordon (D-TN).
Source: Library of Congress.
- To require the adoption and utilization of digital signatures by Federal agencies and to encourage the use of digital signatures in private sector electronic transactions.

UETA

UNIFORM ELECTRONIC TRANSACTIONS ACT

PURPOSE:

The Uniform Electronic Transactions Act is designed to support the use of electronic commerce. The primary objective of this act is to establish the legal equivalence of electronic records and signatures with paper writings and manually-signed signatures, removing barriers to electronic commerce.

Completed by the Uniform Law Commissioners in 1999.

UCC Amendment

A Few Facts About The...

Amendements to UCC Articles 2 and 2A

PURPOSE:

Article 2 of the Uniform Commercial Code has governed the sale of goods since its promulgation in 1951. UCC2 has been amended to accommodate electronic commerce and to reflect development of business practices, changes in other law, and interpretive difficulties of practical significance. UCC2A provides a legal framework for leases of personal property; it has been amended to update and modernize the Article, and to conform to the changes in Article 2.

Completed by the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws and the American Law Institute in 2003.

UCC Article 2 Amendment

- Electronic transactions are enforceable
- Electronic signature defined
- Statute of Frauds = \$5K
- Contract formation separated from terms
- Consumer contracts
- Shipment terms deleted

Path Forward; Mike's View

- Find a technical guru who understands the business process – it's NOT an IT function.
- Demand computer literacy of employees
- Demand computer literacy of vendors
- Use an electronic payment mechanism
- Manage the data flow between users and suppliers - not transactions
- Integrate Auditors and Electronic Records

- 2005 QA, Safety, Internal Audit, Project Managers, etc.

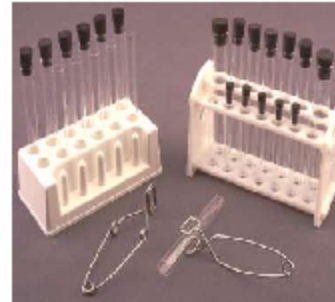
